

U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Conducting Fifth Five-Year Remedy Review at Pollution Abatement Services Superfund Site, Oswego, New York

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is currently conducting the fifth five-year review of the cleanup activities at the Pollution Abatement Services Superfund site, located in Oswego, New York. The purpose of the five-year review is to ensure that the implemented cleanup at the site is functioning as intended and continues to be protective of public health and the environment. To conduct the five-year review, EPA will review site operations, maintenance, and monitoring information, as well as the status of the land-use controls.

It is anticipated that the five-year review will be completed in December 2018. Once the five-year review is completed, the results will be made available on the City of Oswego website at: http://www.oswegony.org/
