

LEGAL NOTICE

NOTICE is hereby given that the Electrical Board of Examiners for the City of Oswego will be administering a Master Electrician License Examination, at **1:00 p.m.** on **Wednesday, July 28, 2021**, in the Mayor's Conference Room, Second Floor, City Hall, 13 West Oneida Street, Oswego, New York.

Applications for the examination may be obtained at the Engineering Office, located on the Third Floor, City Hall, 13 West Oneida Street. Applications are also available on-line at www.oswegony.org, under "Personnel Employment Applications." A **non-refundable** fee of two hundred dollars (\$200.00), cash or check made payable to the **City of Oswego**, is required to be submitted with the application. All applications and fees must be submitted to the Engineering Office by **5:00 p.m.**, on **Wednesday, June 16, 2021**.

In accordance with Article II., Section 108-11(B) of the Electrical Standards of the City of Oswego, New York, "Any master electrician who shall produce good and sufficient proof to the Board of Examiners that he is a master electrician and has been, exclusive of all other occupations, engaged as such for 10 years or more last past shall not be required, before having license issued to him, to take or submit to any examination as herein provided, but such license shall be issued to him only if the municipality wherein he is duly licensed for 10 years shall reciprocally allow master electricians licensed in the City of Oswego for 10 years to obtain a license in that said community without the necessity of taking a test. The applicant under this section would also pay the required fee for the license."
